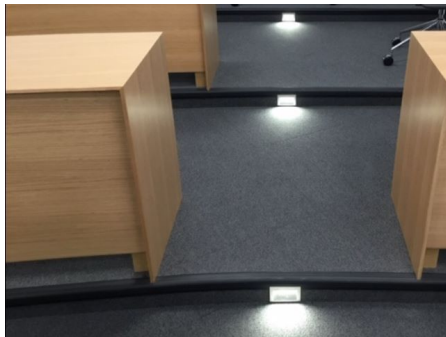

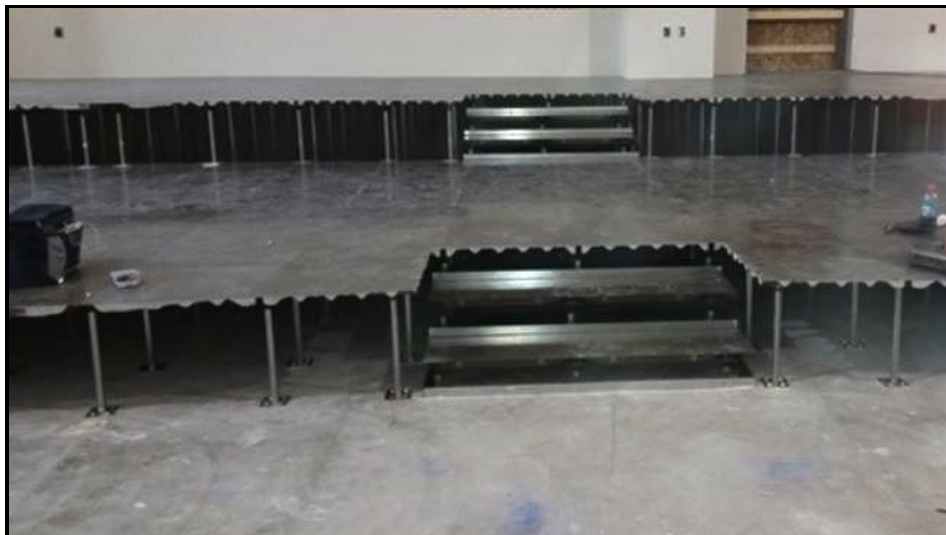
Cleveland Clinic Samson Pavilion

Cuyahoga Community College used underfloor utility distribution for their media center renovation. By running low voltage power and data under the floor they were able to provide the utilities necessary for a training center.
